Opened in 2008, our new Orange County-Irvine Medical Center offers advanced technology with a personal touch. Cutting-edge medical facilities are balanced with open spaces and healing gardens to enhance patient recovery and promote well being. Smart planning allows us to expand to accommodate our community's growth. The facility currently has:

- 150 beds (will expand to 250)
- 8 labor and delivery rooms
- 100% private rooms
- 70 physician offices
- 36-bed Emergency Department
- Onsite occupational health center
