At the West Los Angeles Medical Center, members can access a variety of distinctive services, such as weekly farmer's market and an On-the-Spot Health Education Center for walk-in health consultations. And with 7435 physicians and 2,500 staff members who speak more than 80 languages, care is easier to access for members of all cultures. The facility has:

- 305 beds
- 24-hour pharmacy
- 56 emergency treatment rooms
- 13 operating rooms
- Onsite occupational health center

Raising the bar for specialized care

When special attention is required, we offer centers where physician specialists focus on a particular area of medicine such as spinal surgery or cardiovascular care. At these centers, doctors and their teams perform high volumes of specialized procedures. Aided by the latest technology and research, these medical teams often break new ground as they work toward optimum results. Centers at this facility include:

Supporting the diverse needs of our community

Caregivers at this hospital have partnered with our Institute for Culturally Competent Care to support our large membership of African Americans, establishing a specialized care module that helps diagnose, treat, and manage the diseases most common to this community. Our Congestive Heart Failure Program is one of the largest in the county and our Sickie Cell Medical Care Program is one of the only comprehensive, nonacademic programs in the country that offers pediatric and adult care in addition to education for transitioning to adulthood with the condition.
